

Fees structure 2018/2019

This document shows fees payable for the 2018/2019 academic year, as at 5 February 2018. Fees are reviewed annually and are subject to change. All fees are quoted in Singapore dollars and include 7% Goods and Services Tax (GST), where applicable. GST is subject to change.

Technology costs (1:1 devices including individual laptop in Grade 6 and above) and many resources (i.e., textbooks) are included in the school fees. Other compulsory costs are outlined overleaf. Fees that apply to a small number of students, or are optional, for example learning support, English as an Additional Language, Mother Tongue Language support or optional trips, are not outlined here but are advised by the relevant department. Bus fees are set by the bus provider and are invoiced directly by them.
